#### MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Hadih dear Sinkut View Family,

I hope this message finds you all well as November is wrapping up. The darkness and cold temperatures are now very noticeable, and we all have to put a bit of extra effort into self-care and constructive ways to stay alert and in learning mode. Please dress warmly and nourish yourselves as much as you can. I hope December 's festivities bring more joy and calm than stress and pressure to your lives.

You may have noticed the "hadih" in my weekly messages to you? Hadih is Dakelh and part of the language learning with Mrs. John. I am very grateful I get to learn this unique language, as it originated here and is the only place on the planet where it is spoken. It was a lot more common before 100-150 years ago. Currently only approximately 1000 people\* speak it. That is not a lot of people when you consider the geographical area that is Dakelh territory.

In our home, we speak English and some Swedish. I also speak (and learn) some German and French. These are languages from other parts of the world, and I love speaking and learning them! Language learning helps my brain grow; I can feel it! English is spoken by app.1.5 billion people in the world, French app. 320 million, German app.130 million and Swedish app. 11 million.

Dakelh, on the other hand, is an endangered language. It is unique as it is a language that originated here in this territory, on this land. Sounds and words have emerged from sounds and knowledge of the land and seasons, truly unique to this place. What a gift to learn this and so different from the other languages I am speaking and learning. As a BC Public School, we are committed to the ongoing Truth and Reconciliation journey where Indigenous languages are a fundamental and valued element of Canadian culture and society. Thank you, Mrs. John for supporting us with this learning.
