### MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

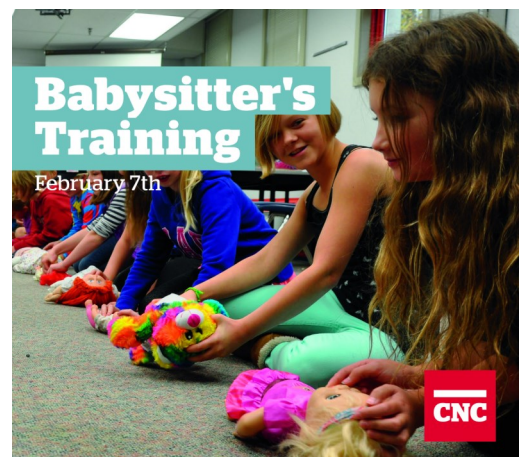
Hadih Parents,

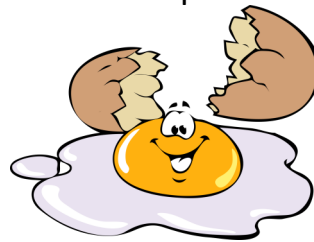
