Monday, May 5, is Murdered and Missing Indigenous Women's Day across Canada. Students will be doing some age-appropriate activities connected to the significance behind this day. Also, at all SD91 buildings, the flag for this day will be flown. The red hand across the flag represents all of the missing Indigenous sisters whose voices are not heard. Friday, May 16th is SD91's annual Share the Love Day. At Sinkut View, students and staff will be listening to a video message from our superintendent, Ms. Anita McClinton. Students will also have the opportunity to listen to a book about inclusion and acceptance which will be a reminder that everyone belongs and is valued and welcome, regardless of who they are. 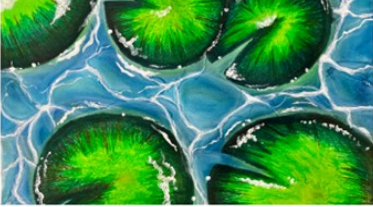

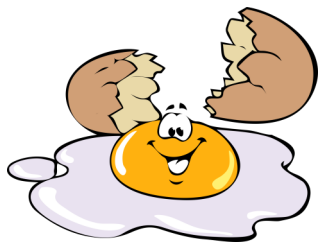
