Hadih parents,

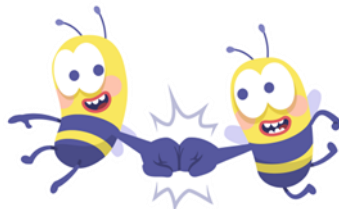
This morning, we had a successful fire drill. Every-thing went exactly as it should. Well done, students and staff!

Draft 2027-28 School Calendar

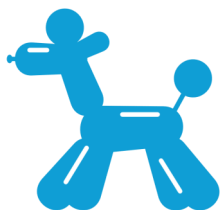

Reminder: If a student is getting picked up from school by a parent/guardian, they are NOT permitted to wait outside for their ride.

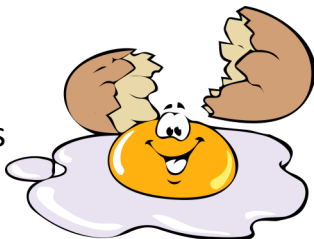
ALL students waiting to be picked up must come down to the office and wait there for their ride. Students can never wait outside alone.
