MS. MOUTRAY'S SWEDISH PEPPARKAKOR (GINGER THINS)

Ingredients:

- 200 g butter
- 100 ml syrup (golden)
- 1 cup of sugar
- 2.5 tsp cinnamon
- 1.5 tsp ground ginger
 1.5 tsp ground cloves
- 100 ml cold water
- 450 g all purpose flour
- 1 tsp baking soda



Instructions:

- In a saucepan, melt butter and stir in the syrup, sugar, cinnamon, ginger and cloves. Remove from stove.
- 2. Add the cold water. Let mixture cool.
 3. Mix in the already blended flour and baking soda
- Mix in the already blended flour and baking
 Work the dough until smooth.
- 5. Let the dough rest for the day or overnight.
- 6. Roll out dough very thinly using more flour (the thinner the better!)
- 7. Use cookie cutters to create the cookies.
- 8.Use lined baking sheets (parchment paper lined)
- 9.Bake in oven for app. 6 minutes in 400 degrees Fahrenheit (or until golden/light brown)

Superintendent's Report to the Board


Superintendent Anita McClinton presented her <u>Monthly</u> Report at the Regular School Board Meeting on Monday, December 15, 2025.
