MS. MOUTRAY'S SWEDISH PEPPARKAKOR (GINGER THINS)

Ingredients:

- 200 g butter
- 100 ml syrup (golden)
- 1 cup of sugar
- 2.5 tsp cinnamon
- 1.5 tsp ground ginger
- 1.5 tsp ground cloves
- 100 ml cold water
- 450 g all purpose flour
- 1 tsp baking soda



Instructions:

1. In a saucepan, melt butter and stir in the syrup, sugar, cinnamon, ginger and cloves. Remove from stove.
2. Add the cold water. Let mixture cool.
3. Mix in the already blended flour and baking soda.
4. Work the dough until smooth.
5. Let the dough rest for the day or overnight.
6. Roll out dough very thinly using more flour (the thinner the better!)
7. Use cookie cutters to create the cookies.
8. Use lined baking sheets (parchment paper lined)
9. Bake in oven for app. 6 minutes in 400 degrees Fahrenheit (or until golden/light brown)
