Hadih parents,

Welcome to October! On Friday, we held our Terry Fox run. So far, we have made almost \$100 for cancer research. Families are welcome to send a bit of money for this cause for the remainder of this week. Next week, we will send the money off. Well done to everyone – and it was great seeing a number of parents out for the assembly and the Terry Fox run outside afterwards.

On Tuesday, October 22, students will be dismissed at 12:00. Teachers will be available to meet with available parents between 1 and 5. 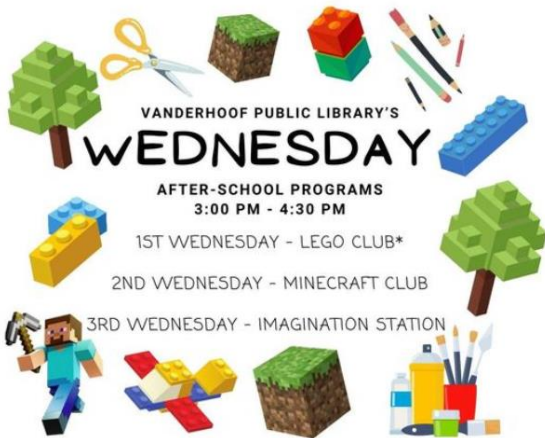

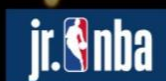
