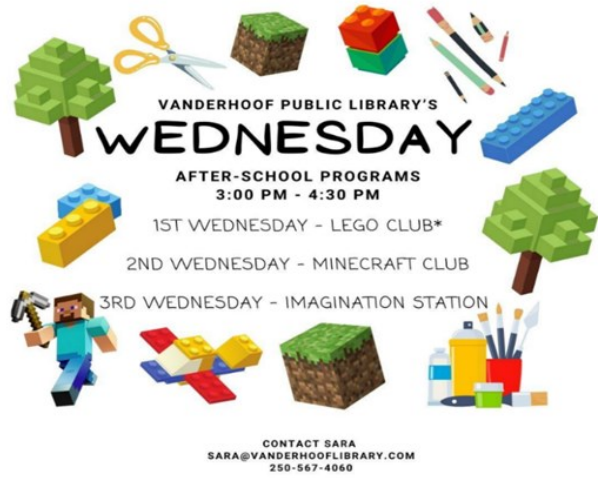
Hot Lunch Orders
