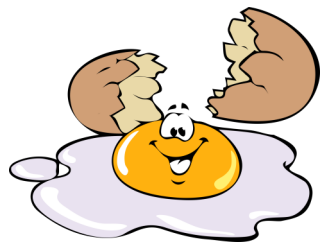

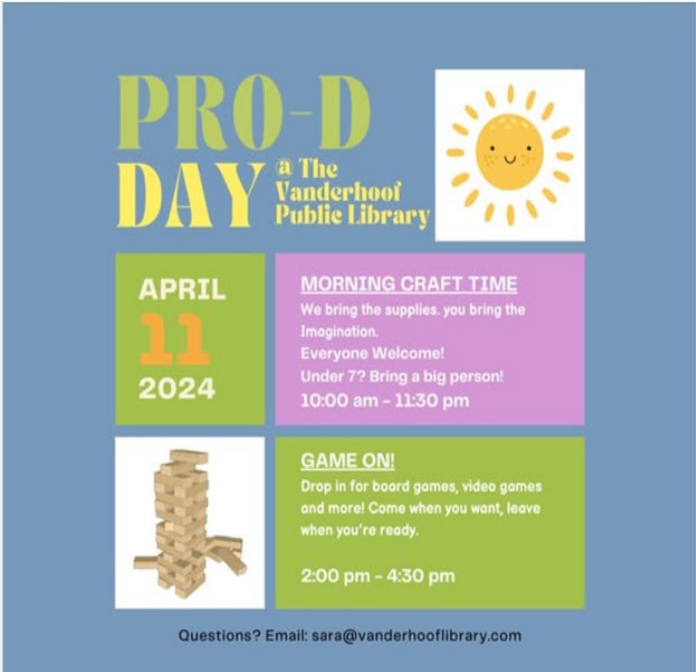
Hot Lunch Orders
