Hadih parents,

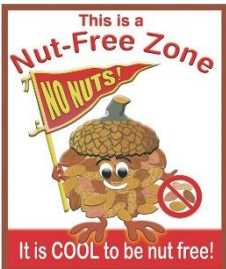

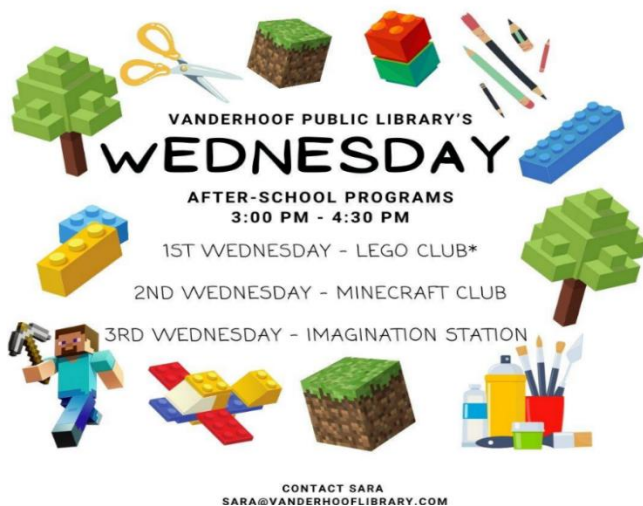

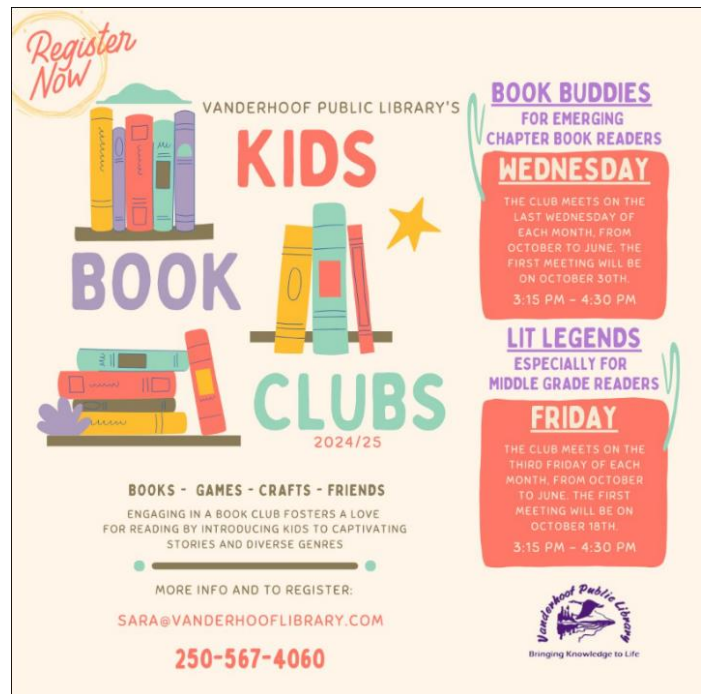
